We try our very best to be fair and equitable when making the costly decision to tow vehicles. We give an additional warning prior to towing vehicles, the first being the warning displayed on the signs at every uncovered parking space. And, when someone has violated these parking rules, even after receiving their additional warning, we will still try and track down the vehicle's owner prior to towing the vehicle.

Please follow these rules. They are here for your safety and to try and make as many spaces available to our residents as possible. Please do not put us into the position of having to tow your vehicle.

Please note: Vehicles parked in the Red Zones or illegally parked in a resident's assigned covered parking space receive no warnings before being towed. Also, only the CDA HOA Board or Staff can call the towing company for these vehicles to be towed. If you find a vehicle parked in your assigned covered parking space, please call the Onsite Manager.

Gardening Spaces

Through the years the Association has encouraged our residents to use portions of the Association Common Area property to grow various plants to beautify our complex. If you are interested in planting your own garden, please contact the Onsite Manager to determine what area you can use.

Please note the general rule is that anything you plant in the ground becomes Association property. However, anything you maintain in a planter or pot remains yours. Despite that, however, all these plantings, whether in the ground or in a pot are on Association property and must be properly maintained at all times. If you do not maintain your plantings, the Association shall maintain or remove the plantings as necessary.

Project Updates

1. The Fire Safety Equipment project is almost complete. So far, over 70% of units inspected have failed to have all the required equipment. If you still have not had your appointment, please contact the Onsite Manager to schedule it.
2. The pool filters have reached the end of their useful life. We will be replacing them with sand filters, which provide the advantages of low cost, low maintenance, and are more environmentally friendly.

Architectural Guidelines

We want to remind everyone that there are only four items that are authorized to be on balconies. They are plants, a table and chairs, bikes and a BBQ. If you have anything else on your balcony, it must be removed. The balconies are not to be used as storage areas.

Also, no blinds, screens, tarps, etc., can be mounted anywhere around your balcony. If you have a back patio, none of these items, including umbrellas, can be placed in the patio area if they can be seen over the fence.
